

VILLAGE OF ADDYSTON

ORDINANCE NO. 2010-08

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
AND VILLAGE CLERK TO SELL A 2006 CHEVROLET
IMPALA POLICE VEHICLE FOR \$3,000.00 TO THE
VILLAGE OF CAMDEN, OHIO

WHEREAS, the Village's 2006 Chevrolet Impala is not needed for municipal purposes and said vehicle has an estimated value of \$3,000.00 as the Village has attempted to sell said motor vehicle for the past three months, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor, as the individual having supervision of or management of said motor vehicle, has determined it is not needed for municipal purposes; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Addyston, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Village Clerk is authorized to sell said 2006 Chevrolet Impala, VIN 2G1WS551869417988 for the sum of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) "as is" to the Village of Camden, Ohio.

SECTION 2. That the Village Clerk is hereby authorized to draw and pay warrants for expenses necessary to transfer title or effectuate the sale of 2006 Chevrolet Impala, VIN 2G1WS551869417988.

SECTION 3. That Village Council has authorized the Mayor and Village Clerk to publicize the Village's desire to sell said motor vehicle at a prior regularly scheduled council meeting.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to dispose of personal property no longer needed for municipal purposes and eliminate any and all liability associated with the ownership of said motor vehicle.
