

VILLAGE OF ADDYSTON

ORDINANCE NO. 2013- 09

AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING PART TIME
POLICE CHIEF FOR THE VILLAGE OF ADDYSTON

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code requires every Village to have a designated police chief appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the legislative authority of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor nominated Dorian LaCourse for the position of Addyston Chief of Police to the Village Council and Village Council approved the appointment of Dorian LaCourse to the position of Addyston Police Chief; and

WHEREAS, a physical is required prior to his permanent appointment as full time Chief of Police of the Village; now therefor

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Addyston, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the position of Chief of Police for the Village shall be a part-time position of thirty-eight hours per week until completion of a physical by the current appointee.


SECTION 2. That the annual compensation for the position of part-time police chief shall be a salary of \$44,000.00 per year effective September 13, 2013.

SECTION 3. That the chief of police shall receive additional compensation for attendance at Mayor's Court based on an hourly rate of \$21.15 at time and one-half for the Chief's attendance at Mayor's Court.

SECTION 4. That the chief of police shall attend all council meetings and other meetings required that are determined by the Mayor to be incidental to the duties of chief of police without additional compensation.

SECTION 5 That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the protection of the residents of the Village and the enforcement of ordinances within the Village.
