ORDINANCE APPOINTING SPECIAL PROSECUTORS  
FOR ADDYSTON MAYOR'S COURT

WHEREAS, the Village Solicitor will be unavailable for the prosecution of Mayor's Court for the first session in the month of October 2013; and


WHEREAS, the Village Solicitor has recommended that Nicholas Klingenschmidt or Thomas Molony prosecute cases in the Addyston Mayor's Court in the absence of the Village Solicitor; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Addyston, County of Hamilton, State of Ohio

- Section 1. That Nicholas Klingenschmidt and Thomas Molony are designated as special prosecutors in the absence of the Village Solicitor for the purpose of prosecuting the cases in the Addyston Mayor's Court.
- Section 2. That the Village Solicitor shall pay the compensation of the special prosecutors from the annual compensation the Village Solicitor is to receive.
- Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance and shall go into effect forthwith and the necessity for said ordinance is to prosecute offenders in the Addyston Mayor's Court and to preserve the peace and dignity of the Village of Addyston.
