

VILLAGE OF ADDYSTON

ORDINANCE NO. 2023- 01

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND  
VILLAGE CLERK TO MAKE APPLICATION FOR H2OHIO INITIATIVE

Whereas, the Village of Addyston Council desires to make an application for the H2Ohio Initiative for the first and second application periods for public water systems that need equipment for valve exercising, leak detection, or meter accuracy; and

Whereas, Village Council and the Addyston Board of Public Affairs has determined the residents of the Village of Addyston would benefit from one or more of the following items of equipment available or eligible under the grant, to wit: valve exercising equipment, clamp on flowmeters to check accuracy of meters, pressure loggers, pilot tube kits to measure hydrant flow and perform hydrant condition assessment, amplified listening devices to detect leaks in the distribution system, metal pip locators, and training on the use of the foregoing equipment;; now therefore

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE OF ADDYSTON,  
STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Village Clerk are authorized to enter make applications for the initial application period and the second application period when it is announced for the H2Ohio Initiative.

Section 2. The Mayor and Village Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to make application for the for the H2Ohio Initiative as directed in the attached Exhibit A for the first and second application periods.

Section 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to

timely submit applications to improve the water system of the Village of Addyston.
