**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
AND VILLAGE CLERK TO ENTER INTO
AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
WITH CITY OF CINCINNATI FOR
SEWERAGE SERVICE CHARGE BILLING & COLLECTIONS**


WHEREAS, Village Council desires to authorize the Mayor to enter into a contract an Intergovernmental Agreement for Sewerage Service Charge Billing & Collections between the Village of Addyston, by and through the Addyston Board of Public Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council has determined it is in the best interest of the residents of the Village of Addyston to continue the Sewerage Service Charge Billing & Collections contract with the City of Cincinnati as amended in the attached Exhibit A; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by Council of the Village of Addyston, State of Ohio:


- Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized to enter into the agreement attached hereto and marked Exhibit A after the approval by the Addyston Board of Public Affairs and approval by Village Council of the Addyston Board of Public Affairs approval of the attached Exhibit A with the City of Cincinnati on behalf of the Village of Addyston.
- Section 2. That the Mayor upon signing the Sewerage Service Charge Billing & Collections agreement attached hereto shall forward the contract to the City of Cincinnati.
- Section 3. That the Mayor shall provide to the Village Clerk a fully executed copy of the Sewerage Service Charge Billing & Collections contract upon receipt from the City of Cincinnati and the Mayor shall also provide a fully executed copy to the Addyston Board of Public Affairs.
- Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to provide for collection of Metropolitan Sewer charges by the Addyston Board of Public Affairs provided to the Village.
